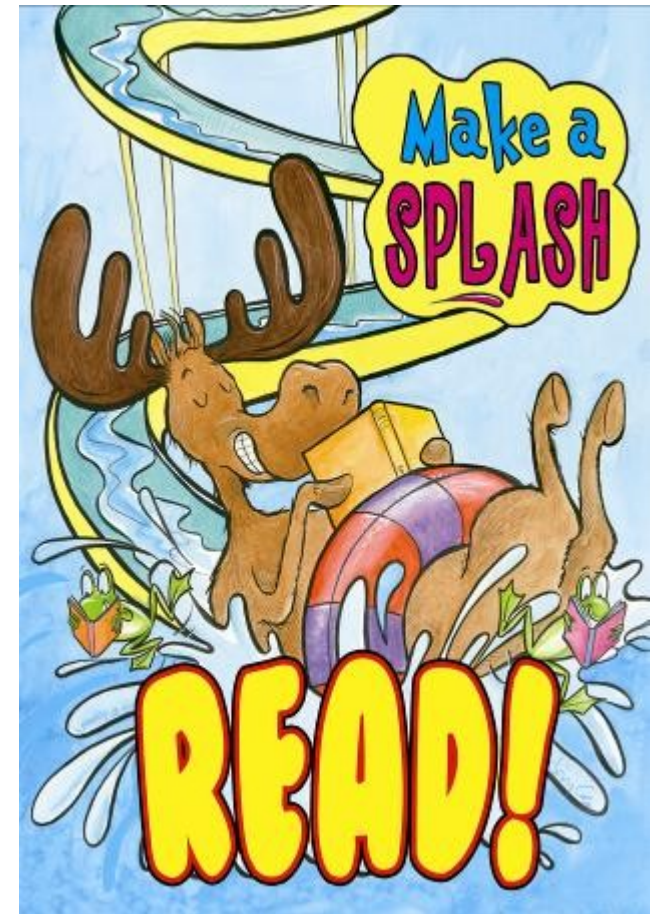

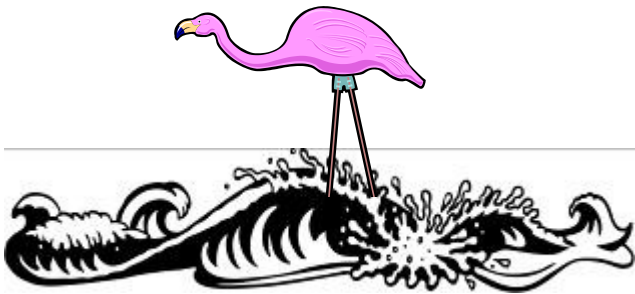
## Activities at the library
