For our Pre-k kids, this includes challenges to read and do different things, for kids in K-6, this includes reading 10 books and logging the titles and authors.

- Complete 5 activities on the Pre-k log, or read 10 books on the K-6 log and get a prize!
- Keep reading to earn prizes
- at the end of summer, our top readers will earn even bigger prizes during our End of Summer party
