

## SERVICES

Our library is a part of a larger system which allows us to offer you more services that if we were on our own.

The system offers e-book, e-audio, e-magazines, access to all the books that the libraries within the system own, (Place a hold and pick up, the book or movie, at Madrid) digital access to historical newspapers, use of ancestry.com, digital databases, and free access to continuing adult education through Universal Class.

We have a fax machine, printers, computers for the public to use with internet connection, free WiFi, adult fiction and non-fiction, children's picture books, easy readers, chapter books, and non-fiction, young adult books fiction and non-fiction, and movies in DVD format as well as a few Blu Ray.

The following are the cost of services offered by the Hepburn Library of Madrid:


1. The fee for black and white copies and printing is \$.15 per copy. (double-sided is \$.20)
2. The fee for color copies and printing is \$.50 per copy.
3. The fees for faxes is: \$1.00 for the 1st page and \$.15 per page after that.
4. Laminating is available for \$.25 a sheet.

You can borrow books, DVDs, and other items from your library using your North Country Library System card.

Using our online catalog, search for items in all 65 of our member libraries and place holds on them from home. Choose to have all your items delivered to your home library, or change the pickup location to suit you.

You can also access digital resources from our online catalog, including:
